## CIVIL/DAMAGES: Provides for exemplary damages when injuries are caused by a driver operating a motor vehicle while using a wireless telecommunications device

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Civil Code Article 2315.10, relative to damages; to provide for an award of
3	exemplary damages under certain circumstances; to provide relative to injuries
4	caused by the use of certain telecommunication devices while driving; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Civil Code Article 2315.10 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	Art. 2315.10. Additional damages; use of wireless telecommunications devices
9	while driving
10	In addition to general and special damages, exemplary damages may be
11	awarded upon proof that the injuries on which the action is based were caused by a
12	wanton or reckless disregard for the rights and safety of others by a defendant who
13	was using a wireless telecommunications device while operating a motor vehicle on
14	a public road or highway of this state in violation of R.S. 32:300.5 through 300.8,
15	and such violation was a cause in fact of the resulting injuries.

Abstract: Authorizes an award of exemplary damages in actions where the injuries were caused by a defendant who was using a wireless telecommunications device while operating a motor vehicle.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 32:300.5) prohibits a person from operating any motor vehicle upon any public road or highway of this state while using a wireless telecommunications device to write, send, or read a text-based communication or while using a wireless telecommunications device to access, read, or post to a social networking site.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 32:300.6-300.8) prohibits, with certain exceptions, the use of a wireless telecommunications device in any manner while driving by a person who holds a Class "E" learner's license or intermediate license, by a minor, and by a person operating a motor vehicle in a school zone.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes an award of exemplary damages in actions where the injuries were caused by a wanton or reckless disregard for the rights and safety of others by a defendant who was using a wireless telecommunications device while operating a motor vehicle on a public road or highway of this state in violation of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 32:300.5-300.8), and such violation was a cause in fact of the resulting injuries.
