Abstract: Extends the moratorium on licensure of level 4 adult residential care providers to July 1, 2023.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a moratorium on licensure of new level 4 adult residential care providers, known commonly as "assisted living facilities", until July 1, 2017. <u>Proposed law</u> extends the moratorium until July 1, 2023.

<u>Present law</u> (Act No. 417 of the 2017 R.S., Section 2) provides that an extension of the moratorium until July 1, 2018 will become effective in the event a specific appropriation by the legislature is made for such purposes and the program receives approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>.
