Abstract: Relative to the sale of motor fuel, changes the attorney general and district attorneys' enforcement of provisions of <u>present law</u> to an authorized action. Allows injunctive relief and attorney's fees under certain circumstances.

<u>Present law</u> governs retail sales of motor fuel. <u>Present law</u> provides that it is an unfair trade practice for a retailer to sell motor fuel below cost including taxes, fees, and transportation charges when such sale will impair or injure competition.

<u>Present law</u> requires the attorney general and the district attorneys to enforce the provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows, but does not require, the attorney general and the district attorneys to enforce the provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows any person damaged, or threatened with loss or injury, under <u>present law</u> to sue for injunctive relief.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that any person who is successful in a suit for injunctive relief be allowed reasonable attorney's fees.

<u>Proposed law</u> mandates the right to seek injunctive relief and attorney's fees extend to any duly organized and existing trade union when any one or more members has been damaged by a violation of <u>present law</u>.
