2	To amend and reenact R.S. 32:318(H), relative to audible and visual signals on certain
3	vehicles; to authorize the use of blue lights on licensed ambulances; to provide with
4	respect to the definition of "ambulance"; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 32:318(H) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§318. Audible and visual signals on certain vehicles
8	* * *
9	H. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all publicly-owned
10	publicly owned fire department vehicles and publicly-owned all licensed
11	ambulances may use blue-colored electric lights. The lights shall be on the rear of
12	the vehicle and shall not exceed fifty percent of the visual lights. For purposes of
13	this Section, the term "ambulance" shall have the meaning ascribed in R.S.
14	<u>40:1131(3).</u>

Luneau

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the use of blue-colored electric lights on all publicly owned fire department vehicles and publicly owned ambulances.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to authorize use of blue-colored electric lights on all licensed ambulances.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the term "ambulance" as used in <u>proposed law</u> shall have the meaning ascribed in R.S. 40:1131(3) that defines "ambulance" as any authorized emergency vehicle, equipped with warning devices, designed and operated as a part of a regular course of conduct or business to transport a sick or injured individual or which is advertised or otherwise held out to the public as such. "Ambulance" shall not mean a hearse or other funeral home vehicle utilized for the transportation of the dead.
