Amendments proposed by Representative Ivey to Engrossed House Bill No. 391 by Representative Pearson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 2, line 7, after "<u>D.</u>" insert "<u>(1)</u>"
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 2, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

5 "(2) "Running waters" shall not include waters passing over a privately-owned water bottom that has been gated under a permit issued by 6 the state land office. In order to qualify for a permit to close a running water, 8 the land owner shall submit a permit application fee of twenty-five dollars, 9 apply to the state land office for the permit, and clearly document ownership 10 of the water bottom to the satisfaction of the state land office. Upon issuance of the permit by the state land office, the owner of the water bottom shall 11 12 place a metal sign on the obstruction over the waterway that clearly and 13 permanently displays the state land office permit number, the owner of the 14 water bottom, and current contact information for the land owner including 15 phone number and email address. For any waterway that has been closed without a permit from the state land office or that does not have a sign 16 17 indicating the information required by this Paragraph, the person closing the 18 waterway shall be subject to a civil fine of one thousand dollars per closure per day. The provisions of this Paragraph shall be enforceable by state and 19 20 parish law enforcement and the fine shall be payable to the agency citing the 21 violation."
