- On page 1, delete lines 6 through 17 in their entirety and delete page 2 in its entirety and
- insert in lieu thereof the following:
- "Section 1. R.S. 37:2708.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§2708.1. Qualifications; faculty member in a social work program

A. A faculty member with a master's degree in social work who teaches a course in social work at an accredited Louisiana institution of higher education shall obtain the registration provided for in R.S. 37:2706 within six months of commencement of his teaching status if he resides in Louisiana.

- B. A faculty member with a master's degree in social work who teaches a course in social work at an accredited Louisiana institution of higher education shall obtain the equivalent of the registration provided for in R.S. 37:2706 or licensure as provided for in R.S. 37:2707, as issued by his state of residence, within six months of commencement of his teaching status if he resides outside of Louisiana. If his state of residence does not have an equivalent registration or licensure, he shall be eligible for registration with the board pursuant to R.S. 37:2706 or licensure pursuant to R.S. 37:2707.
- C. The board shall have thirty days from the date of receipt of an application submitted pursuant to this Section to act upon the application. Failure to act within thirty days shall be considered an approval of the application.
- D. A faculty member who teaches a course in a social work program at an accredited Louisiana institution of higher education in which he has obtained a degree or license in a field other than social work shall not be construed as practicing social work and shall not be subject to the provisions of this Chapter.
- E. An administrator, staff member, or faculty member in a school of social work at an accredited Louisiana institution of higher education who does not teach a course to students shall not be subject to the provisions of this Chapter.
- F. The board may promulgate in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act any rules necessary to implement the provisions of this Section. However, the board shall not impose any restrictions on faculty at an accredited Louisiana institution of higher education more restrictive than provided for in this Section."
