1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Margaret Britton on achieving the Girl Scout Gold Award.

3 WHEREAS, Margaret "Maggie" Britton, a Girl Scout for the past thirteen years, is  
4 the daughter of Eugene and Janet Britton, sister to Ana and Emma, and currently a senior at  
5 East Ascension High School in Gonzales, Louisiana; and

6 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts of the United States of America is the world's largest and  
7 most preeminent organization dedicated solely to all girls everywhere and to helping girls  
8 build character and gain skills for success in the real world; and

9 WHEREAS, the Girl Scout Gold Award is the highest achievement within the Girl  
10 Scouts of the United States of America and can only be earned by senior and ambassador  
11 Girl Scouts; and

12 WHEREAS, earning the Girl Scout Gold Award is no easy task and less than six  
13 percent of eligible Girl Scouts successfully earn the award; and

14 WHEREAS, to earn the award, each candidate must demonstrate a special  
15 commitment to herself, her community, and the future; and

16 WHEREAS, she must also complete extensive requirements designed to develop her  
17 values, knowledge, skills, and leadership abilities; and

18 WHEREAS, the requirements to earn the Girl Scout Gold Award include a project
