## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

This is an urge and request resolution that may not result in a fiscal impact. To the extent that the LLA performs the audit as specified in the resolution, New Orleans Sewerage & Water Board would realize an increase in expenditures by \$46,000. The cost estimate assumes the LLA will spend approximately 418 hours at the current billable rate of \$110 per hour. LLA indicates that the New Orleans Sewerage & Water Board has approximately 52 active contracts that are being monitored.

The proposed resolution may result in an increase in self-generated revenue as a result of the recovering costs incurred by the Legislative Auditor's Office. Pursuant to RS 24:517.1 the legislative auditor shall be reimbursed the actual costs incurred with conducting local government audits.
