CHILDREN. Requests the Department of Children and Family Services to study extending the age of foster care to age twenty-one.

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Adds two members to the panel which is to advise the Dept. of Children and Family Services in connection with the study called for in the Resolution.
 - (a) Executive director of La. Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics.
 - (b) Executive director of La. Partnership for Children and Families.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Requests the Dept. of Children and Family Services (DCFS) to study the feasibility of extending the age of foster care to 21 and submit a report of its recommendations to the legislature no later than Feb. 1, 2019.

Requests DCFS to convene an 11-member panel to advise the department in connection with the study.
