SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH. Designates May 2, 2018, as LMA Municipal Day at the state capitol.

A RESOLUTION

To designate Wednesday, May 2, 2018, as LMA Municipal Day at the state capitol.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Municipal Association (LMA) was founded in 1926 and is a 501(c)4 nonprofit organization serving as a unified voice for Louisiana's municipal governments; and

WHEREAS, the LMA is a statewide member organization that advocates on behalf of three hundred three municipalities and two parishes; and

WHEREAS, the LMA also includes five subsidiaries: Risk Management, Inc., Louisiana Municipal Advisory and Technical Services Bureau (LaMATS), Louisiana Municipal Gas Authority, Louisiana Community Development Authority, and Louisiana Municipal Association of Unemployed Compensation Program; and

WHEREAS, the LMA encompasses six affiliate entities: the Louisiana Association of Tax Administrators, Louisiana Recreation and Parks Association, Louisiana City Attorneys Association, Louisiana Municipal Clerks Association, Louisiana Association of Municipal Secretaries and Assistants, and Building Officials Association of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, representation from the affiliate entities and from the Municipal Employees Retirement System of Louisiana, the Louisiana Fire Chiefs Association, the Louisiana Airport Managers and Associates, the Louisiana Conference of Mayors, the
