## **DIGEST**

<u>Present law</u> provides that in order to protect the public health, the state health officer shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments.

<u>Proposed law</u> stipulates that the requirements of the sanitary code shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment that does not meet the definition of a "public water system" as defined in <u>present law</u>.

(Amends R.S. 40:4(A)(1)(c))

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the original bill:

1. Revise <u>proposed law</u> to provide that the rules and regulations required by <u>present law</u> relative to regulation of retail food establishments shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the</u> engrossed bill

1. Provides that the requirements in the sanitary code shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment that does not meet the definition of a "public water system" as defined in <u>present law</u>.
