14	agency or official thereof shall be entitled to judicial review under this Chapter.

17	person acting on behalf of the department or official in appeals brought pursuant to
18	Children's Code Article 616.1.1.

1 В. 2 3 (3)(a) Nothing in this Section shall affect the right to or manner of judicial 4 appeal in any adjudication, irrespective of whether or not such adjudication is 5 commenced by the division or by an agency. 6 (b)(i) However, no agency or official thereof, or other person acting on 7 behalf of an agency or official thereof, shall be entitled to judicial review of a 8 decision made pursuant to this Chapter. 9 (ii) The provisions of Item (i) of this Subparagraph shall not apply to the 10 Department of Children and Family Services or an official thereof or other person 11 acting on behalf of the department or official in appeals brought pursuant to 12 Children's Code Article 616.1.1. 13 14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 15 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 16 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 17 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 18 effective on the day following such approval.
