SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Stipulate that nothing in <u>proposed law</u> shall be construed to require chart orders for any medications administered in-center in outpatient dialysis facilities or for any medications for treatment of end-stage renal disease administered as part of home-based dialysis treatments.
- 2. Adds prohibition on use of prescription drug information for data mining or marketing purposes.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the defined term "chart order" and its corresponding definition to <u>present law</u>, the Louisiana Pharmacy Practice Act.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the use of chart orders with respect to electronic prescribing of noncontrolled legend drugs. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for bidirectional electronic transmission of chart orders in certain circumstances.

<u>Proposed law</u> stipulates that it not be construed to require chart orders for any medications administered in-center in outpatient dialysis facilities or for any medications for treatment of end-stage renal disease administered as part of home-based dialysis treatments.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the use of patient prescription drug information or any other information sent by electronic prescription for data mining or marketing purposes, including data with no personal identifiers or re-identified from anonymized data. Provides that violations are deemed to be an unfair method of competition and an unfair or deceptive act or practice.

Effective August 1, 2018.
