SB 433 Reengrossed 2018 Regular Session Chabert

<u>Present law</u> provides for the membership of the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority.

Proposed law adds the lieutenant governor, or his designee, as a member of the board.

Effective July 1, 2020.

(Amends R.S. 49:214.5.1(B)(15); adds R.S. 49:214.5.1(16))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

- 1. Adds the Lieutenant Governor, or his designee, as a member of the board.
- 2. Provides that the speaker of the House and president of the Senate shall be authorized to vote and be counted for purposes of a quorum.
- 3. Technical amendments.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Natural Resources and</u> <u>Environment</u> to the <u>reengrossed</u> bill:

- 1. Remove the provisions that authorized the speaker of the House and president of the Senate to vote and be counted for purposes of a quorum.
- 2. Make the bill effective July 1, 2020.
