2	To designate the week of May 14-20, 2018, as Police Week in the state of Louisiana and to
3	commend the service of Law Enforcement officers and Law Enforcement agencies
4	throughout Louisiana.
5	WHEREAS, members of Law Enforcement agencies provide a vital public service
6	and have essential roles in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the citizens of Louisiana;
7	and
8	WHEREAS, approximately nine hundred thousand Law Enforcement officers serve
9	their communities across the United States; and
10	WHEREAS, nearly sixty thousand assaults against Law Enforcement officers are
11	reported each year, resulting in approximately sixteen thousand injuries; and
12	WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1791, more than twenty thousand Law
13	Enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of
14	duty, including nine members of the Louisiana Law Enforcement community; and
15	WHEREAS, the names of these notable public servants are engraved on the walls of
16	the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and

1	WHEREAS, many new names of fallen heroes will be added to the National Law
2	Enforcement Officers Memorial this spring, and these new names will include the one
3	hundred thirty-five officers killed in 2017; and
4	WHEREAS, the service and sacrifice of all officers killed in the line of duty will be
5	honored during the thirtieth annual National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund
6	candlelight vigil held on May 15, 2018; and
7	WHEREAS, Tuesday, May 15, 2018, is designated as Peace Officers Memorial Day
8	to honor all fallen officers and their families.
9	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
10	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate the week of May 14-20, 2018, as Police
11	Week in Louisiana and does hereby commend the state's Law Enforcement officers and Law
12	Enforcement agencies throughout Louisiana for their service to the citizens of the state.
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
14	to Law Enforcement agencies across Louisiana and the Louisiana Fraternal Order of Police.
