## HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

## HB 846 2018 Regular Session Simon

SANITARY CODE: Provides relative to water system testing at certain businesses which apply for or hold retail food permits

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Deletes <u>proposed law</u> providing that the rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments required by <u>present law</u> shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.
- 2. Provides that <u>present administrative code</u> relative to retail food establishments shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment which does not meet the definition of "public water system" in <u>present law</u>.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides that in order to protect the public health, the state health officer shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that such regulations shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment which does not meet the definition of "public water system" in present law.
