The chair of the Louisiana Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority Board, or his designee.

The dean of the College of the Coast and Environment at Louisiana State University, or his designee.

The director of the Water Institute of the Gulf, or his designee.

The executive director of the La. Beverage Assoc., or his designee.

The executive director of the Lake Pontchartrain Basin Foundation, or his designee.
