<u>Prior law</u> provided for the procedure in which a sheriff conducts timber sale by sealed bids and prohibited the sale if the highest bid is less than the minimum price established by the office of forestry.

<u>New law</u> changes office of forestry to Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> but prohibits the sale by the sheriff when the register of the state land office determines that a sale by the sheriff is not in the best interest of the state, and authorizes the register of the state land office to conduct a sale by utilizing sealed bids, with no bid being accepted if less than the minimum price established by the department.

Effective August 1, 2018.
