<u>Present law</u> prohibits the wearing or possessing of body armor on school property, at school-sponsored functions, or in firearm-free zones.

<u>Present law</u> provides exceptions for wearing body armor on school property, at school-sponsored functions, or in firearm-free zones.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides an exception allowing students to carry, wear, or possess bullet-resistant backpacks on school property or a school bus.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
