## HB 748 2018 Regular Session Emerson

LICENSING: Establishes the Occupational Licensing Review Act

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Deletes all provisions of the Occupational Licensing Review Act.
- 2. Requires the governor to review on an annual basis 20% of agencies engaged in regulatory and licensing activities. Further requires all such agencies to be reviewed by governor within five years.
- 3. Requires information obtained from annual reviews to be made available to the public in a timely manner.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides relative to reports to the governor by regulatory agencies.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the governor to request and receive, in such manner and at such time as he may direct, information relating to the activities of certain agencies.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires the governor to review on an annual basis not less than 20% of the agencies engaged in regulatory and licensing activities.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that within five years, the governor shall have reviewed all such agencies.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires information obtained from annual reviews to be made available to the public in a timely manner.
