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Provides relative to the Major Events Incentive Program Fund and Louisiana Economic Development

Proposed law allows the Secretary of the LA Dept. of Economic Development (LED) to enter in a contract with local organizations to recruit a qualified event subject to legislative appropriation and with approval of the Commissioner of Administration and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget (JLCB) . Proposed law states that incentive commitment to a qualified event shall be an amount appropriated by the legislature. Proposed law allows JLCB to enter into executive session to discuss details on a bid for a qualifying event. Proposed law provides the treasurer shall disburse monies to an eligible entity in accordance with the legislative appropriation. Proposed law adds "WWE Wrestlemania" to the list of qualified events for the Major Events Incentive Program.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

For illustrative purposes, to the extent an event qualifies to receive incentives through the Major Events Incentive Program, the legislature would appropriate incentive amounts to the Major Events Incentive Program Subfund within the LA Mega-Project Development Fund for eventual disbursement to an eligible entity. It is assumed that incentive amounts would be derived from the state general fund.
