HB 602 2018 Regular Session Miguez

WEAPONS/FIREARMS: Provides relative to the carrying of a concealed handgun at a school

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Amends the exception to the crime that prohibits the carrying of a firearm on school property, at school-sponsored functions, or in a firearm free zone, to provide that the exception for a concealed handgun permit holder applies if the person carries the concealed weapon within 1,000 feet of any school campus.
- 2. Reinstates the provision of <u>present law</u> which provides that a concealed handgun permit does not authorize nor entitle the permit holder to carry a concealed handgun into a school, school campus, or school bus.
- 3. Removes from <u>proposed law</u> the provisions relative to the carrying of a concealed handgun into a school, school campus, or school bus by a concealed handgun permit holder who is also a student, teacher, administrator, or employee of a school, which includes the removal of provisions relative to the school's authority to regulate the carrying of firearms and the school's immunity from liability for damages arising from or related to a visitor's use or failure to use a firearm.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for a crime which prohibits the carrying of a firearm or dangerous weapon by a student or nonstudent on school property, at school-sponsored functions, or in a firearm free zone, and further provides for specific exceptions to this offense. <u>Present law</u> further provides for certain exceptions to this offense.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the issuance of a concealed handgun permit for a person who meets certain eligibility and training requirements, but further provides that a concealed handgun permit does not authorize nor entitle the permit holder to carry a concealed handgun in certain places, including into a school, school campus, or a school bus.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds an exception to the <u>present law</u> crime for any person who has a valid concealed handgun permit issued pursuant to <u>present law</u> who carries a concealed handgun within one thousand feet of any school campus.
