MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Provides for a hold on the renewal of an operator's license under certain circumstances

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Authorizes the judge of the court exercising jurisdiction to use discretion in the issuance of a suspension of an operator's license.
- 2. Removes proposed law changes regarding the present law fee.
- 3. Removes <u>proposed law</u> provisions requiring the promulgation of rules.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> requires that the magistrate or judge of the court exercising jurisdiction immediately forward to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections notice of failure to appear with information necessary for identification of the arrested person, which automatically results in the suspension of an operator's license.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the magistrate or judge, at his discretion, to determine whether to suspend or place a hold on the renewal of the operator's license of the arrested person and requires notice include an indication of whether a suspension or hold on renewal should be placed on the operator's license but otherwise retains present law.
