Require instruction and display of the national motto "In God We Trust" in public schools. (gov sig)

Present law requires a program of instruction on the flag of the U.S. to be provided by the 5th grade as part of the social studies curriculum, including etiquette, customs pertaining to display and use, and other patriotic customs as defined by the federal US Code. Proposed law expands this to include instruction on the national motto "In God We Trust" and requires each school board to display the motto in each building it uses and in each school under its jurisdiction. The nature of the display shall be determined by each governing authority with a minimum requirement of a paper sign.

Effective upon governor's signature.
