<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Office of State Fire Marshal will provide electronic access to its information management system to the State Board of Architectural Examiners and the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board, for the examination and reproduction of plans, drawings, and specifications submitted to the office of State Fire Marshal. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the State Board of Architectural Examiners and the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board will not allow for examination or release of any documents obtained from the Office of State Fire Marshal's information system to the public or other third party, including other state agencies. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Office of State Fire Marshal will not be held responsible or liable for any release of confidential, proprietary, or trade secret information by the State Board of Architectural Examiners or the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

PUBLIC RECORDS

<u>Proposed law</u> will result in a \$45,000 expenditure increase for the Office of State Fire Marhsal (OSFM) for one-time changes to the Information Management System (IMS) to provide access to the State Board of Architectural Examiners and the Louisiana Profession Engineering and Land Surveying Board. Funding for the OSFM is primarly provided through statutory dedications. <u>To the extent existing funding sources are insufficient to cover the one-time cost, SGF budget authority may be required.</u>

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the OSFM to provide electronic access to the IMS for these boards for the examination and reproduction of plans, drawings, and specifications submitted to the OSFM. Additionally, <u>proposed law</u> does not allow these board to release the plans, drawings, and specifications to any third party or state agency, and further provides that the OSFM will not be held liable for the release of any such information. In practice, plans, drawings, and specifications submitted to the OSFM for review are stored electronically in the IMS with built-in securities to restrict access to confidential, proprietary and trade secret information. One-time modifications to the IMS will be required to provide the appropriate level of access for these boards and to implement an audit trail of system access. For informational purposes, OSFM reports 17,500 plan submissions annually.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
