SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 119

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to

update its rules relative to certification requirements for behavior analysts and ensure

that such rules conform with R.S. 37:3701 et seq.

WHEREAS, BESE Bulletin 746 provides for ancillary school service certificates and

establishes specific requirements for certification of school therapists, including initial

eligibility requirements and renewal guidelines for certification of behavior analysts; and

WHEREAS, these rules were promulgated prior to passage of the Behavior Analyst

Practice Act, as enacted by Act 351 of the 2013 Regular Session of the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, some of the terminology used in BESE's rules are inconsistent with and

may even conflict with the Behavior Analyst Practice Act; and

WHEREAS, discrepancies between the language in the rules and the law may cause

confusion for parents and stakeholders who are trying to ensure that needed behavioral

interventions are provided to students; and

WHEREAS, providing consistent, uniform terminology could decrease the confusion

and ensure that students receive the services they need.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby

request the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to update its rules

relative to certification requirements for behavior analysts and ensure that such rules

conform with R.S. 37:3701 et seq.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the

president of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state

superintendent of education.
