1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

5 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 17, and insert:

6	"Section 1. R.S. 39:24.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§24.2. Incentive expenditure program annual report
8	A. The Department of Revenue shall perform an annual comprehensive
9	return on investment analysis for all incentive expenditures, as defined by R.S.
10	39:2. This return on investment analysis shall be performed by the department
11	regardless of which agency administers the incentive expenditure program. The
12	department shall make a report of the results to the commissioner of
13	administration no later than October fifteenth each year. The report shall
14	include a ranking of the incentive expenditure programs by return on
15	<u>investment.</u>
16	B. Upon receipt of the return on investment analysis from the
17	Department of Revenue, the commissioner of administration shall review the
18	incentive expenditures in conjunction with the agencies that administer the
19	incentive expenditures and make recommendations to the Joint Legislative
20	<u>Committee on the Budget regarding each incentive expenditure program at the</u>
21	January meeting following receipt of the analysis. The commissioner shall
22	recommend one or more of the following with respect to each incentive
23	<u>expenditure program:</u>
24	(1) Make specific modifications to the incentive expenditure program to
25	<u>improve the return on investment.</u>
26	(2) Eliminate the incentive expenditure program, either immediately or
27	by phase-out.
28	(3) Authorize structured pay-outs of rebates or structured usage of
29	credits for the incentive expenditure program.
30	(4) Convert a current incentive expenditure program to a loan or grant
31	program.
32	(5) Provide for annual front or back end caps for the incentive
33	<u>expenditure program.</u>
34	(6) Require a specific appropriation for the incentive expenditure
35	program.
36	(7) Make no changes to the incentive expenditure program.
37	C. The commissioner's recommendations shall ensure that no executed
38	incentive expenditure contract is impaired.
