<u>Prior law</u> provided relative to the crimes of rape and sexual battery. <u>Prior law</u> further provided that lack of consent is an element of these crimes under certain circumstances.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and adds that for purposes of the <u>prior law</u> crimes of rape and sexual battery, a person is deemed incapable of consent when the person is under arrest or otherwise in the actual custody of a police officer or other law enforcement official and the offender is a police officer or other law enforcement official who either:

- (1) Arrested the person or was responsible for maintaining the person in actual custody.
- (2) Knows or reasonably should know that the person is under arrest or otherwise in actual custody.

Effective upon signature of the governor (May 23, 2018).
