Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Reduce the appropriations out of the state general fund by \$3,000,000.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Increase appropriations out of the state general fund by \$17,459,818 for vouchers and nonpublic educational assistance.
- 2. Authorize the secretary of state to deposit certain prior year self-generated revenues into the Voting Technology Fund.
- 3. Specify that payments for rural hospitals in the La. Dept of Health FY 2018-2019 appropriations shall be no less than the FY 2017-2018 amount.
- 4. Allocate \$50,000 of the Medical Vendor Payments to Private Providers to the Teche Action Clinic for the Health Primary Care Pilot Program.
