SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 28

REAL ESTATE. Requests state to establish programs and other incentives to encourage first-time homebuyers to purchase homes in this state.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the state of Louisiana and future legislators of this state to take steps
3	toward establishing programs and other incentives to assist and encourage first-time
4	homebuyers to purchase homes in this state.
5	WHEREAS, House Bill No. 383 of the 2018 Regular Legislative Session, authored
6	by Representative Paula Davis, sought to create a rebate for eligible costs a first-time
7	homebuyer expends from his savings account for the purchase of a single-family residence
8	in this state; and
9	WHEREAS, the House Committee on Ways and Means reported the bill with
10	amendments, but due to the attached fiscal note, the bill was recommitted to the House
11	Committee on Appropriations; and
12	WHEREAS, when the bill was heard in the House Committee on Appropriations, the
13	state budget was in a precarious position, and due to concerns regarding the state budget,
14	Representative Davis requested to voluntarily defer the bill; and
15	WHEREAS, legislators and other parties were in favor of the concept of assisting
16	first-time homebuyers, but were hesitant to do so during a time when the state was facing
17	fiscal uncertainty; and
18	WHEREAS, home ownership provides shelter and security to families and fosters

involvement in community life as well as participation in democratic institutions; and 1 2 WHEREAS, for every two homes sold, a job is created, with home sales in this 3 country supporting more than two and one-half million private-sector jobs in an average 4 year; and WHEREAS, of the nonhomeowners who were surveyed to complete the January 5 6 2018 Aspiring Home Buyers Profile of the National Association of Realtors®, forty-six 7 percent were thirty-four years old or under, fifty-seven percent earned an income of less than 8 fifty-thousand dollars per year, eighty percent said homeownership is part of their American 9 dream, and thirty-six percent of all respondents in the study, including both homeowners and 10 nonhomeowners, stated that saving for a down payment in their current financial situation 11 would be very difficult; and WHEREAS, states across the country have passed legislation creating First-Time 12 13 Homebuyer Savings Accounts as an incentive to encourage homeownership and assist 14 nonhomeowners with realizing their American dream; and 15 WHEREAS, Louisiana should take similar steps to provide such homeownership 16 incentives, because homeownership creates a myriad of benefits for the homeowner, society, 17 and the economy. 18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana 19 does hereby urge and request the state of Louisiana and future legislators of this state to take 20 steps toward establishing programs and other incentives to assist and encourage first-time 21 homebuyers to purchase homes in this state, which may also be a realization of their 22 American dream.
