2	To commend the Honorable H. Eugene "Gene" Reynolds, and to express enduring gratitude
3	for his outstanding contributions to Bossier and Webster parishes and the state of
4	Louisiana, particularly during his tenure as a distinguished member of the Louisiana

16	WHEREAS, sworn in on January 9, 2012, Representative Reynolds, who is a
17	member of the North Louisiana Legislative Delegation and Louisiana Legislative Rural

19	Agriculture, Forestry, Aquaculture and Rural Development, the House Committee on

1	Commerce, the House Committee on Education, the House Committee on Natural Resources
2	and Environment, and the House Committee on Retirement; and
3	WHEREAS, in 2012, Representative Reynolds was the recipient of the Louisiana
4	Association of Educators "You Made the Grade" Award in recognition of his support for
5	education initiatives; the following year, Representative Reynolds received the Southwest
6	Louisiana Chamber of Commerce LegisGator Award for his support of statewide business
7	initiatives; and
8	WHEREAS, as chairman of the Louisiana House Democratic Caucus from 2016 to
9	2018, Representative Reynolds provided highly effective leadership as caucus members
10	worked to address the needs of Louisiana and her citizens; and
11	WHEREAS, Representative Reynolds is supported by his loving wife, Martha, and
12	he is the proud father of Dustin and Cole; and
13	WHEREAS, as he prepares to begin work in his new role, assistant secretary of the
14	office of state parks, Representative Reynolds merits a sincere measure of commendation
15	for his singular contributions as an exceptional member of the Louisiana House of
16	Representatives.
