HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 32

A RESOLUTION

To commend Pastor Major James Mayanja Sseruwagi of the Ugandan Military for his charitable work at Revive A Life Orphanage in Uganda.

WHEREAS, Pastor Major Sseruwagi is a pastor at City Pentecostal Revival Center Church of Uganda and patron of the Revive A Life Uganda Orphanage and Charitable Care Centre; under his direction, the orphanage will expand to include land for mixed farming, more housing, expansion of the school, and a clinic building; and

WHEREAS, the Revive a Life Orphanage was founded in 2002 and currently houses four hundred children, ages two to sixteen; residents are housed at the orphanage for a variety of reasons, including accidents, HIV/AIDS, natural diseases, and war; and

WHEREAS, as of October 2014, the Sudanese conflict had affected two million people and displaced more than five hundred thousand people; among these were at least twenty thousand children, mostly boys, who were separated from their families; and

WHEREAS, the "lost boys" trekked great distances seeking refuge from the fighting; survivors are in camps and orphanages in Kenya, the Sudan, and Uganda, including the Revive A Life Uganda Orphanage; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Major Sseruwagi merits recognition for his work to meet community needs by caring for children at Revive A Life in Uganda.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Pastor Major James Mayanja Sseruwagi of the Ugandan Military for his charitable work at Revive A Life Orphanage in Uganda; does hereby recognize and record for posterity his dedication to the well-being of the hundreds

of children living at the orphanage; and does hereby extend to him every good wish for continued success and happiness in the future.
