

1 WHEREAS, a study of the necessity and fairness of the amounts of the fees that may
2 be charged for an expungement should be undertaken, and a uniform and streamlined
3 procedure for the payment and collection of these fees should be developed.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
5 urge and request the Louisiana State Law Institute to study and make recommendations for
6 the revision of laws regarding expungement fees.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute work in
8 conjunction with the Louisiana District Attorneys Association, the Louisiana Public
9 Defender Board, the Louisiana Sheriffs' Association, the Louisiana State Police, the
10 Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Criminal Justice, the
11 Louisiana Clerks of Court Association, and any other agencies or associations deemed
12 appropriate by the committee regarding this study.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute shall report
14 its findings and recommendations to the Louisiana Legislature no later than February 1,
15 2019.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
17 Louisiana State Law Institute.
