<u>Existing law</u> provides, relative to the crime of stalking, that the court may, in addition to any penalties imposed pursuant to <u>existing law</u>, grant a protective order which directs the defendant to refrain from abusing, harassing, interfering with the victim or the employment of the victim, or being physically present within a certain distance of the victim.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and authorizes the court to order that the defendant be prohibited from possessing a firearm for the duration of the Uniform Abuse Prevention Order.
