Existing law provides for the Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission which is comprised of the following members:

- (1) The chief justice of the supreme court or an associate justice of the supreme court appointed by the chief justice.
- (2) One senator appointed by the president of the Senate.
- (3) The commissioner of administration.
- (4) The vice president for Administration and Management, Southern University and A&M College or his designee.
- (5) One representative appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives.
- (6) One representative appointed by the La. District Attorneys Association.
- (7) One representative appointed by the state public defender.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and adds a representative of the Families and Friends of Louisiana's Incarcerated Children to the membership of the Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission.

Effective August 1, 2018.
