Prior law prohibited a person holding a retail dealer's permit from permitting the illegal sale, offering for sale, possession, or permitting the consumption of any type of *narcotic or habit forming drug* on the premises of certain alcoholic beverage outlets.

Existing law prohibits a person holding a retail dealer's permit from permitting the illegal sale, offering for sale, possession, or permitting the consumption of any type of *controlled dangerous substances* on the premises of certain alcoholic beverage outlets.

New law retains existing law as it pertains to prohibiting a person holding a retail dealer's permit from permitting the illegal sale, offering for sale, possession, or permitting the consumption of any type of *controlled dangerous substance* on the premises. New law expands the prohibition to include *all other illegal substances*.

Effective August 1, 2018.
