Existing law provides that purchases of \$10,000 or more but less than \$30,000 must be made by obtaining not less than three telephone or facsimile quotations.

<u>New law</u> expands the methods for submission in <u>existing law</u>, adding email or other printable electronic forms.

<u>Prior law</u> required written confirmation of the accepted offer for both telephone and facsimile quotations.

<u>New law</u> requires written confirmation of accepted offers accompany any telephone quotes received.

<u>New law</u> provides an exemption from <u>new law</u> and <u>existing law</u> for the purchase by any local law enforcement or local public safety agency of animals trained to perform special tasks such as narcotics detection, bomb detection, arson investigation, and rescue services.
