New law defines "camera", "common area", and "short-term rental structure".

<u>New law</u> prohibits the use of a camera on the premises of a short-term rental structure except as provided by new law.

<u>New law</u> provides that the owner or lessor of a short-term rental structure may install or use a camera only in the common areas of the structure provided notice of the use of cameras is posted on the premises.

<u>New law</u> provides that an owner or lessor of a short-term rental structure shall not use any audio, video, or photographic footage obtained pursuant to <u>new law</u> for any commercial or exploitative purpose nor shall he make the footage available to members of the public.

<u>New law</u> provides that any guest documented in footage obtained in violation of <u>new law</u> shall have a civil cause of action against any owner or lessor who obtained, used, or made available the footage in violation of <u>new law</u>, and shall be entitled to actual damages, reasonable attorney fees, and punitive damages.

Effective August 1, 2018.
