Existing law provides relative to reports to the governor by regulatory agencies.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the governor to request and receive, in such manner and at such time as he may direct, information relating to the activities of certain agencies.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and requires the governor to review on an annual basis not less than 20% of La. state agencies engaged in regulatory and licensing activities.

New law requires the governor to have reviewed all such agencies within five years.

<u>New law</u> requires information obtained from annual reviews to be made available to the public in a timely manner.

Effective August 1, 2018.
