Riser

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 3:4601 et sq.) provides for the Louisiana Weights and Measures Law, which sets the standards and requirements for the sale of all agriculture commodities. Further requires the Department of Agriculture and Forestry to supervise the weights, measures, and weighing and measuring devices offered for sale, sold, and used in the state.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

SB 55 Original

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 3:4623(C)) exempts the sale of shelled field corn from the Louisiana Weights and Measures Law if the net weight of the shelled field corn is verified by a National Type Evaluation Program (NTEP) certified scale prior to distribution of the shelled field corn.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts the sale of shelled field corn made directly from a producer to a purchaser if the following conditions are met:

- (1) The shelled field corn is measured from a timed distribution device.
- (2) The net weight of the shelled field corn is verified by a National Institute of Standards and Technology certified floor scale.

Effective August 1, 2019.
