Proposed law increases this fee to \$95.00.

Present law provides the fee for "Delinquent fees" is \$250.00.

Proposed law increases this fee to \$300.00.

<u>Present law</u> provides the fee for "Annual X-ray certificate registration" is \$25.00.

Proposed law increases this fee to \$35.00.
