Tarver

<u>Present law</u> requires a child younger than one year of age or who weighs less than 20 pounds to be restrained in a rear-facing child protective system.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to increase the age <u>from</u> one year <u>to</u> two years.

<u>Present law</u> requires a child who is at least one year of age but younger than four years of age or who weighs at least 20 pounds but less than 40 pounds to be restrained in a forward-facing child restraint system.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to increase the age <u>from</u> one year <u>to</u> two years and to increase the weight <u>from</u> less than 40 pounds <u>to</u> less than 60 pounds.

Effective August 1, 2019.
