6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 37:1174(A)(4) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1174. Qualifications
9	A. Each pharmacist member of the board shall at the time of appointment:

11	(4) Have five two years of experience in the practice of pharmacy in this state
12	after licensure.

Present law requires a pharmacist member of the Board of Pharmacy to have five years of experience in the practice of pharmacy in this state after licensure. Proposed law reduces the years of experience from five years to two years.

Effective August 1, 2019.
