**Abstract:** Provides alternative means of verifying that a person is twenty-one years or older for the purpose of selling or serving alcoholic beverages.

Present law provides a list of certain types of identification to be used for verifying the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.

Proposed law retains the present law list of certain types of identification and provides an alternative method (real-time verification) that may be used to verify the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages. Requires the commissioner of ATC to authorize the real-time age verification system.
