Abstract: Requires the installation of remote monitoring equipment on certain failing sewage lift stations.

<u>Present law</u> grants the secretary of the Dept. of Environmental Quality the duty to prepare and develop a general plan for the protection and control of the waters of the state, including the permitting of sewage treatment facilities.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the issuance of a compliance order that requires the installation of remote monitoring equipment when the violation of <u>present law</u> resulted in a sewage overflow caused or substantially caused from a failure in the same lift station more than five times in a 12 month period.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the order provide for a reasonable time for the installation of the required remote monitoring equipment.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the secretary to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the APA necessary to implement the provisions of proposed law.
