**Abstract:** Modifies the requirements for the selection of commissioners to serve on the Vermilion and Iberia Railroad Development District board.

<u>Present law</u> requires two members to be appointed by the governing authority of the parish of Vermilion and at least one of those members must have a bachelor's degree in agricultural science.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement that at least one member have a bachelor's degree in agricultural science and instead requires the member to have a desire to serve on the board and be a member of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury.

<u>Present law</u> requires that the member appointed by the Twin Parish Port Commission and the University of La. at Lafayette have a bachelor's degree in engineering and a minimum of five years experience at the management and operational level of a railroad company.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement that the member have a minimum of five years experience at the management and operational level of a railroad company, thus <u>proposed law</u> solely requires the member to have a bachelor's degree in engineering.
