<u>Present law</u> provides for an annual appropriation for the councils on aging. <u>Present law</u> provides for an allocation of \$2.50 per person age 60 or older in the parish based on the latest official census estimate. Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a minimum allocation per parish in the amount of \$37,500. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the per parish minimum <u>from</u> \$37,500 <u>to</u> \$100,000.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a total minimum annual appropriation for the councils on aging in the amount of \$2,776,800. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the total minimum annual appropriation <u>from</u> \$2,776,800 <u>to</u> \$6,900,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes provision providing a maximum allocation for any one parish council on aging of \$100,000 unless additional funds are appropriated.
