SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16

HEALTH DEPARTMENT. Requests the La. Department of Health to add Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) to the state's newborn screening panel.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Louisiana Department of Health to take such actions as are
3	necessary to add Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) to the newborn screening panel
4	of this state.
5	WHEREAS, SMA is a progressive neurodegenerative disease that affects motor
6	nerve cells in the spinal cord, diminishing all physical strength, impeding the ability to walk,
7	swallow, and in severe cases, the ability to breathe; and
8	WHEREAS, SMA is the leading genetic cause of death for infants today, annually
9	affecting approximately one out of eleven thousand babies born nationwide and
10	approximately six babies born in Louisiana; and
11	WHEREAS, SMA is detectable through genetic testing, and early detection of this
12	disorder is vital to ensure the expedited treatment and survival of babies born with SMA; and
13	WHEREAS, newborn screening identifies babies with congenital disorders like
14	SMA; and
15	WHEREAS, in 2018, United States Health and Human Services Secretary Alex Azar
16	approved the recommendation of the Federal Advisory Committee on Heritable Disorders
17	in Newborns and Children (ACHDNC) to add testing for SMA to the Recommended
18	Uniform Screening Panel (RUSP) for newborns; and

1	WHEREAS, nearly four million newborns are screened annually in the United States
2	for numerous diseases, and seven states are currently screening for SMA; and
3	WHEREAS, screening for SMA in a newborn is not included in Louisiana's current
4	newborn screening panel.
5	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
6	urge and request the Louisiana Department of Health to take such actions as are necessary
7	to add SMA to the newborn screening panel of this state.
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
9	secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health.
