Proposed law prevents <u>freestanding emergency departments</u> in Louisiana, unless licensed by the department as a part of a hospital under the Hospital Licensing Law (R.S. 40:2100), either as a part of the hospital's main campus or as a separate off site campus of an existing licensed hospital.

Proposed law further prevents the Louisiana Department of Health from issuing a license to any <u>off-site campus emergency</u> <u>department</u> if the emergency department is within the primary service area of a rural hospital (primary service area as defined in R.S. 37:1307(6)).
