1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To recognize Wednesday, April 10, 2019, as Pastor Appreciation Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, sometimes called Clergy Appreciation Day, Pastor Appreciation Day
4	celebrates the contributions of priests, pastors, reverends, and ministers in the U.S.; and
5	WHEREAS, Pastor Appreciation Month was established in 1922 by pastors and
6	religious workers; and
7	WHEREAS, the celebration of Pastor Appreciation Day has a biblical foundation in
8	1 Timothy 5:17, where St. Paul wrote that the elders of the church are worthy of double
9	honor and in 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13, where he wrote that those who work hard among you
10	should be held in the highest regard for their work; and
11	WHEREAS, priests, pastors, reverends, and ministers collectively serve a global
12	Christian population which is fifty percent Catholic and which includes 800 million
13	Protestants and 160 million Orthodox believers; and
14	WHEREAS, pastors and their families deserve thanks for the unparalleled love and
15	commitment they share with the people of Louisiana on a daily basis; and
16	WHEREAS, it is appropriate, especially on this day, for all Christians to express their
17	gratitude to those who give spiritual direction to their lives; and
18	WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to recognize Pastor Appreciation Day at the state
19	capitol.
20	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
21	recognize Wednesday, April 10, 2019, as Pastor Appreciation Day at the state capitol and
